Winter Tax Notices will be mailed December 1 and are payable thru February 14 without penalty. A three percent penalty will be applied February 15 until February 29. Beginning March 1 taxes must be paid to the Shiawassee County Treasurer, with an additional four percent county admin. Fee (\$1 min.) and one percent interest per month. If your tax notice is printed on pink paper a copy has been sent to your mortgage company. There is a drop box located on the front of City Hall for your convenience. Make payments 24 hours a day 7 days a week.

Shiawassee County Dog Licenses are available at the City Clerk/Treasurer's office until February 28. Fees for dog licenses are \$30 for sexed and \$10 for unsexed. Please bring in current rabies certificate when purchasing licenses. Also proof of neutering/spaying, if applicable. Beginning March 1 dog licenses are available only at the Shiawassee County Treasurer's office and the fee is increased.

City Offices will be closed Monday, December 24 and Tuesday, December 25 as well as Monday, December 31 and Tuesday, January 1 for the Holidays.

Leaf & Brush Pick-up

Brush and leaf pick-up has been discontinued until spring. City residents may continue to take yard waste to the compost site located near the lagoon area. Please observe the signs and place the yard waste in the appropriate pile. The area will remain unlocked for your use as long as the privilege is not abused.

Snow Removal

Property owners are responsible for keeping clear and free from ice and snow the sidewalks adjacent to their property. All vehicles must be off curbed streets between 2:00 a.m. - 6:00 a.m. to allow DPW crews to plow the streets in an efficient manner.

Emergency Services

Police protection is provided by the City of Laingsburg Police Department. Emergencies - phone 911. Non-emergencies 989-743-3411 or 517-651-5355 Fire and Ambulance Services are provided by LSW Emergency Services, located at 7425 Woodbury Road, Laingsburg. Emergencies phone 911. Non-emergency and burn permits for bon fire phone 651-2638. No burning is allowed in the city except for bon fire permits issued at the discretion of the Emergency Services Chief.

The emergency siren blows (waxes and wanes) every month at 7:00 p.m on the first Tuesday and at 9:00 a.m. on the third Monday of each month. This occurs just prior to fire practice. It tests the siren to make sure it is working. It may also blow in the event of a fire, letting firefighters now that more help is needed. (Firefighters have pagers/radios). In the event of a tornado warning there will be a **solid blast**, lasting three minutes. An all clear is a solid blast of one minute.
