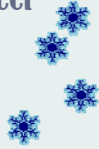

### Sewer use fees are billed quarterly and are due 30 days after billing.

Service from October–December is billed January 1, due January 30  
Service from January–March is billed April 1, due April 30  
Service from April–June is billed July 1, due July 30  
Service from July–September is billed October 1, due October 30.

## Snow Removal

- ❑ The sidewalks adjacent to your property need to be free of ice and snow within 24 hours of the last snowfall. Please **do not** shovel snow into the street as this causes all kinds of drainage and freezing issues.
- ❑ Vehicles need to be off the streets so the plows can get through. The City is not responsible for any damage to vehicles left on the roadway during the snow removal process. Vehicles that are parked on any curbed street between the hours of 2 a.m. – 6 a.m. will be ticketed and/or towed so the snow can be cleared.

are NOT permitted on City streets or in City Parks!!
