Notarized Letter of Burial Rights

According to the City of Laingsburg Ordinance; Cemetery plots are nontransferable without prior written approval by the City. The possession of a burial rights certificate is not itself sufficient evidence on which to record the transfer of ownership of a lot or grave. Legal right to ownership should be established and recorded at the City Clerk's Office. A certified copy of the will and probate proceedings would afford evidence of ownership or heirship.
