LAINGSBURG CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

September 10, 2018

Mayor Culpepper called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers.

Councilor Hill led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present: Marcie Nickols, Dennis Hill, Alan Ducastel, Larry L. Sparkes and Micheal Culpepper. Members absent: David Rhodabeck & Brian Fredline.

Public Comment – A concern was raised regarding the Fire Siren and when it would sound in the event of a tornado. If City Officials are advised by Central Dispatch of a tornado the Siren would be activated.

Moved by Ducastel, seconded by Hill to approve the minutes of August 6, 2018, as presented. Motion carried.

Moved by Ducastel, seconded by Nickols to approve the Treasurer's Report subject to audit. All in favor, Motion carried.




Moved by Sparkes, supported by Nickols to schedule a Public Hearing on the proposed ORV Ordinance to be held during the regular City Council meeting on October 1, 2018. All in favor, motion carried.

Moved by Ducastel, supported by Hill to accept the recommendation of the Planning Commission for the rezoning and Map Amendment for 1.27 acres of land located at 7200 Woodbury Road, Laingsburg MI 48848, Parcel# 022-60-088-001-02 from Residential Low Density to Residential Medium Density. Roll call vote: Yeas: L.L. Sparkes, Hill, Ducastel, Nickols, and Culpepper. Nays: None. Absent: Rhodabeck & Fredline. Motion carried.

Moved by Ducastel, seconded by Hill to pay the bills in the amount of \$412,404.43, using General Fund check numbers 40191 – 40247 and electronic payments of \$495,429.21 for August (which includes tax disbursements of \$705,692.44). Roll call vote: Yeas: Sparkes, Hill, Ducastel, Nickols, and Culpepper. Nays: None. Absent: Rhodabeck & Fredline. Motion carried.

Moved by Ducastel, seconded by Culpepper to adjourn. The motion was unanimous and the meeting adjourned at 7:18 p.m.
