

LAINGSBURG CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

October 1, 2018

Mayor Pro-Tem Larry L. Sparkes called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers. Councilor Rhodabeck led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present: David Rhodabeck, Marcie Nickols, Dennis Hill and Larry L. Sparkes. Members absent: Micheal Culpepper, Alan Ducastel & Brian Fredline.

Public Comment – Commissioner Bartz provided an update on Shiawassee County.

Moved by Hill, seconded by Nickols to approve the minutes of September 10, 2018 as presented. Motion carried.

Moved by Rhodabeck, seconded by Hill to approve the Treasurer's Report subject to audit. All in favor, Motion carried.

Moved by Rhodabeck, supported by Nickols to open the Public Hearing on the proposed ORV Ordinance All in favor, motion carried.

The Police Chief explained that the ORV Ordinance was mirrored after the county's ordinance with only minor changes to accommodate being in the City. The public was offered a chance to speak. Commissioner Bartz spoke stating that the County has not experienced any issues since enactment of their ORV Ordinance. There was no other comment.

Moved by Rhodabeck, supported by Hill to close the public hearing. All in favor, motion carried.

Moved by Rhodabeck, supported by Hill to accept the recommendation of the Planning Commission for the Final Site Plan and Special Land Use Approval at 7200 Woodbury Road, Laingsburg MI, Parcel# 022-60-088-001-02 for a Day Care Center. Roll call vote: Yeas: Rhodabeck ,Sparkes, Hill and Nickols. Nays: None. Absent: Ducastel, Culpepper & Fredline. Motion carried.

Moved by Rhodabeck, seconded by Hill to pay the bills in the amount of \$26,409.36, using General Fund checks 40244 - 40272 and electronic payments of \$29,747.32 for October. Roll call vote: Yeas: Sparkes, Hill, Nickols and Rhodabeck. Nays: None. Absent: Ducastel, Culpepper & Fredline. Motion carried.

Moved by Hill, supported by Sparkes to move the regular November City Council Meeting from the 5th to the 12th per the City Charter it should be the Monday following the election. All in favor, Motion Carried.

Moved by Hill, seconded by Rhodabeck to adjourn. The motion was unanimous and the meeting adjourned at 7:34 p.m.
