August 5, 2019

Moved by Fredline, seconded by Hill to approve the Treasurer's Report subject to audit. All in favor, Motion carried.

Moved by Fredline, seconded by Hill to pay the bills in the amount of \$141,737.70, using General Fund check numbers 40674 – 40724 and electronic payments of \$59,477.02 for August. Moved by Rhodabek, seconded by Nickols to approve the request from Mike Putnam, representing Twilliger's Tavern to have the "Bottom of the Blues Festival" on Saturday September 28, 2019, and to grant temporary authorization for outdoor consumption of beer, wine and liquor in the fenced in area in

front of the premises as long as all licenses, permits and/or bonds are obtained as required by law and to further authorize closure for Grand River Road from Roosevelt Row to South Laing Street from 2:00pm until 12:30am. Cement barriers will be placed on Grand River at Crum, Roosevelt Row and near the intersection of South Laing. Ingress and Egress for Boondocks will be kept clear.
