The City will pick up your **leaves** once you have collected them near the curb. Please place **brush** and leaves in **separate piles** since they are handled with different equipment.



Grass clippings cannot be picked up unless they are bagged in yard waste bags. When you are ready for pickup, just give City Hall a call! Please note, as soon as the snow flies the City will only pick up bagged leaves.

The City also offers a free compost yard where **City residents** can bring their own leaves and brush. The gate will be unlock from 8:00am to 3:00 weekdays. To coordinate a time outside of Department of Public Works hours, please call the DPW before 3:30 at 517-651-5374. Thank you and happy fall!

# Planning Commission:

This is a non-paid commission that meets once per month. Members shall consist of residents representing different professions and occupations with an interest or training in land use related issues. Applicants should have experience in the following fields: Architecture, Building Construction, Civil Engineering, Land Use Planning, Real Estate Development, Economic Development or Government. The Planning Commission meets on the 3rd Monday of the month.

## Library Board:


This is a non-paid board that meets twice per month. Members must be city residents qualified to set policies concerning the management, supervision, and control of City library facilities. Applicants should have experience in the following fields: Policymaking, Personnel Management, Finance, Budget, Advertising, Public Relations, Preparation of Strategic Planning, Grants and Knowledge of Libraries. The Library Board meets typically on the 2nd Monday of the month.

# Zoning Board of Appeals:

This is a non-paid board that meets as needed when appeals arise. Members must be residents of the City and possess an interest or knowledge of land use related issues. One member of the Planning Commission Board shall also be on the Zoning Board of Appeals. Applicants should have experience in the following fields: Architecture, Building Construction, Civil Engineering, Land Use Planning, Real Estate Development, Economic Development or Government.

## Board of Review:

This is a paid position that meets three times per year, briefly in July and December and two full days in March. Members must be electors of the city. Experience and/or training in matters related to real estate is preferred but not required Applicants should have experience in the following fields: Banking, Finance, Property Appraisal, Assessing, Valuation, Real Estate/ Development / Law.
