CITY RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS

Please remember that we all need to work together to keep our City streets and sidewalks safe! Here are some tips that will help us work together this winter:

- * Sidewalks adjacent to your property (home or business) need to be free and clear from ice and snow, with in 24 hours of the accumulation. Please consider that children and elderly use the sidewalks..
- * Vehicles need to be off the streets so the plows can get through. If your vehicle is parked on the street during plowing, it may get plowed in. The City is not responsible for any damage to vehicles left on the roadway during snow removal process.
- * If you must park in city parking spaces, consider parking farther out when a storm is coming. Then the city can clear the closer parking areas first and the other spaces while you're gone or the next day.
- * Thank you for working together to keep Laingsburg a safe place.
